TRIP ITINERARY

DAY 1

Arrival Nairobi (NBO)

Upon arrival atJomo Kenyatta International Airport, and transferred to the Hotel.

The remainder of the day at leisure.

| #Pace of Travel: Relaxed, with a focus on arrival and settling in.

#Steps to Walk: Approximately 1,000-1,500 steps #Facilities: Hotel amenities are available in Nairobi.

#Suitable for Age Group: All age groups, including the elderly and families.

#What to Bring: Comfortable clothes for travel, passport, travel documents.

#What to Do: Arrive at Nairobi, check in at the hotel, relax, and enjoy the day at leisure.

#What not to Do: Avoid strenuous activities on the first day after a long flight.

#Tip for You: Drink plenty of water to adjust to Nairobi's altitude and stay hydrated.

#Overnight: Nairobi.

#Transfers: Transfer from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport to hotel is included.

DAY 2

Nairobi -- Masai Mara (Approx. 300Km/5Hrs)

After breakfast check-out hotel and drive to Masai Mara.

Masai Mara National Reserve offers wonderful scenery and plenty of game.

It is perhaps the only region left in Kenya where the visitor may see animals in the same superabundance as existed a century ago.

Arrive and check in lodge.

Enjoy the afternoon game drive.

| #Pace of Travel: Moderate, with a long drive followed by an afternoon game drive.

#Steps to Walk: Approximately 1,000-2,000 steps #Facilities: Hotel/lodge amenities, including game drive vehicles.

#Suitable for Age Group: Suitable for all ages, but long drives may be tiring for young children or the elderly.

#What to Bring: Comfortable clothes, camera, sunscreen, hat, binoculars for game viewing.

#What to Do: Enjoy the scenic drive to Masai Mara, check in at the lodge, and participate in an afternoon game drive.

#What not to Do: Avoid excessive movement during the game drive to avoid disturbing wildlife.

#Tip for You: Carry motion sickness medication if you're prone to discomfort during long drives.

#Overnight: Masai Mara National Reserve.

#Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

#Transfers: Transfer from Nairobi to Masai Mara is included.

DAY 3

Masai Mara National G.R.

Early morning game drive returning to your lodge for late breakfast.

Morning spent at leisure.

Post lunch, depart for an afternoon game drive in the reserve.

After the game drive back to the hotel and have dinner at the lodge.

| #Pace of Travel: Active, with early game drives and afternoon leisure.

#Steps to Walk: Approximately 1,500 – 2,000 steps #Facilities: Lodge amenities, game drive vehicles, and safari guides.

#Suitable for Age Group: All ages, though the early morning game drive may not be ideal for very young children.

#What to Bring: Comfortable clothes, camera, binoculars, sunscreen, hat, and a jacket for early mornings.

#What to Do: Go on an early morning game drive, enjoy breakfast at the lodge, and relax in the afternoon before another game drive.

#What not to Do: Avoid rushing during the game drive; patience yields better wildlife sightings.

#Tip for You: Bring a light jacket for early morning game drives when temperatures can be chilly.

#Overnight: Masai Mara National Reserve.

#Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

DAY 4

Masai Mara National G.R

Early Morning Game drive in the Masai Mara followed by Breakfast at the lodge, the morning spent at leisure.

Enjoy Lunch at the lodge followed by an Afternoon Game Drive.

Alternatively, after Breakfast, head out for a Full Day Game Drive with a picnic lunch.

Back to the lodge for a Sumptuous.

Optional Balloon Ride at additional cost - Today you have an opportunity to go on a spectacular Optional balloon ride across the Maasai Mara.

The BALLOON SAFARI adventure begins in the pre-dawn hours.

The magnificent view of the park is thrilling.

Towards the end of the safari, you rise to a height of 1500 feet for a panoramic view of the twisting Mara River and the savannah below.

After an hour or so in the air, your safari finishes with a flourish: a champagne breakfast in the bush, cooked on the balloon's burners.

| #Pace of Travel: Active, with options for either two game drives or a full-day excursion.

#Steps to Walk: Approx.

3,000-4,000 steps #Facilities: Lodge amenities, game drive vehicles, and optional balloon ride.

#Suitable for Age Group: Suitable for all ages, but young children might find the full-day game drive tiring.

#What to Bring: Comfortable clothes, camera, sunscreen, hat, jacket for early morning, and cash for an optional balloon ride.

#What to Do: Choose between a morning and afternoon game drive or opt for a full-day safari with a picnic lunch.

If desired, enjoy an optional hot-air balloon ride with a champagne breakfast in the bush.

#What not to Do: Do not wander off the lodge premises without a guide.

#Tip for You: The balloon ride is a spectacular experience, but it requires an early start, so prepare for an exciting day.

#Overnight: Masai Mara National Reserve.

#Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Masai Mara - Nairobi (Approx. 300Km/5Hrs)

After breakfast check out from the lodge and drive to Nairobi.

Arrive in Nairobi and transfer to the hotel.

Rest of the day at leisure.

| #Pace of Travel: Relaxed, with a drive back to Nairobi and leisure time.

#Steps to Walk: Approximately 1,000 – 1,500 steps #Facilities: Hotel amenities in Nairobi.

#Suitable for Age Group: Suitable for all age groups.

#What to Bring: Comfortable clothes, a camera, and snacks for the journey.

#What to Do: Check out from the lodge and drive back to Nairobi.

After arrival, relax at the hotel.

#What not to Do: Avoid rushing, as the drive can be long and tiring.

#Tip for You: Take short breaks during the drive to stretch and stay refreshed.

#Overnight: Nairobi. #Meal: Breakfast.

#Transfers: Transfer from Masai Mara to Nairobi is included.

DAY 6

Nairobi departure (NBO)

After breakfast transfer to the airport to board your onward flight back home.

End of trip.

| #Pace of Travel: Relaxed, with time for a last breakfast before departure.

#Steps to Walk: Approximately 1,000 – 1,500 steps #Facilities: Hotel amenities and airport services.

#Suitable for Age Group: Suitable for all age groups.

#What to Bring: Passport, travel documents, and any last-minute souvenirs.

#What to Do: After breakfast, transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your flight back home.

#What not to Do: Do not forget to check for any last-minute items at the hotel before departure.

#Tip for You: Arrive early at the airport to avoid any stress before your flight.

#Meal: Breakfast.

#Transfers: Transfer from hotel to airport is included.
