

Experience a unique adventure through the heart of Jordan, where history, unspoiled natural beauty, and adventure intertwine in the special "Eye of Jordan" tour. The adventure starts in Jerash, an ancient city dating back to the Bronze Age, and is home to Jordan's most impressive Roman ruins: colonnaded boulevards, temples, sprawling theaters, and minor Byzantine churches are all remarkably intact. You will experience the unparalleled sensation of floating in the Dead Sea, Earth's lowest point, where the salt density is so high that the water will effortlessly keep you afloat. Next, you will visit gorgeous Petra, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where the rose-red city was carved directly from a sheer rock face that creates a landscape quite unlike what you have ever seen—will definitely be left breathless. The journey continues in Wadi Rum, famous for its red-pink sands, hulking mountains, and large rock arches. The desert landscape is simply some of the most majestic land you'll see in the world, and the exhilarating

TRIP ITINERARY

DAY 1

Arrival Amman (AMM)

Upon arrival at Amman airport, you will meet our driver and transferred to the hotel.

Check-in and Dinner at the hotel.

DAY 2

Amman – Jerash – Dead Sea – Amman

Breakfast at the hotel.

Enjoy a full-day excursion to visit Jerash and the Dead Sea.

Jerash is also known as 'The Jewel of the North is one of the largest and most well-preserved sites of Roman architecture in the world, outside Italy.

Continue drive to the Dead Sea, one of the most spectacular natural and spiritual landscapes in the world and the lowest point on Earth.

Return to the hotel in Amman.

10,000 steps #Facilities: Breakfast, guided tours, and transfers #Suitable for Age Group: Ages 12+ (due to moderate walking) #What to Bring: Comfortable walking shoes, sunscreen, hat, and swimwear for the Dead Sea #What to Do: Explore Jerash ruins, float in the Dead Sea, and enjoy the natural mud spa #What Not to Do: Avoid wearing jewelry in the Dead Sea (it may tarnish) #Tip for You: Carry a reusable water bottle to stay hydrated #Overnight: Amman #Meal: Breakfast #Transfers: Hotel to attractions and back

DAY 3

Amman – Madaba - Mt. Nebo, Wadi Al-Mujeb - Kerak - Petra

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today visit the Christian Town of Madaba, which is known as 'The City of Mosaics'.

You will be visiting the St.

George Greek Orthodox Church, where you will see the masterpiece of Madaba (a Byzantine mosaic map of the Holy Land that goes back to the 6th century, showing Jerusalem and other cities).

We will then go to Mt.

Nebo, which is considered to be one of the most important holy sites in Jordan, as it is believed to be the place where Moses climbed from the Valley of Moab, and from where God showed him the Promised Land, as well as Moses' last resting place.

It features ruins from the 4th to the 6th century with marvelous mosaics adorning the grounds of the church still visible.

Proceed via Wadi Al Mujib, a deep valley holding one of Jordan's most breathtaking views.

We will continue our journey to the city of Kerak, where we will visit the Crusader's Castle, with its diverse history dated from the Byzantine to the Mamluk period, and get to know the architectural military brilliance of the Crusaders.

Continue south to the hotel in Petra.

8,000 steps #Facilities: Breakfast, guided tours, and transfers #Suitable for Age Group: Ages 12+ (due to moderate walking and exploration) #What to Bring: Comfortable walking shoes, camera, light layers for varying weather #What to Do: Admire mosaics in Madaba, take in views from Mt. Nebo, and explore Kerak Castle #What Not to Do: Avoid rushing through sites; take your time to absorb the history #Tip for You: Wear comfortable shoes for uneven terrains at historical sites #Overnight: Petra #Meal: Breakfast #Transfers: Hotel to attractions and then to Petra

DAY 4

Petra visit – Wadi Rum – Aqaba

Breakfast at the hotel.

Check out and visit the Nabatean Red Rose city of Petra, one of the seven world wonders and a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Enter the city through a 1 KM-long narrow gorge which is flanked either side by 80m high cliffs! Notice the dazzling colors and formations of the rocks.

The site is massive and contains hundreds of elaborated rock-cut tombs, a treasury, Roman-style theatres, temples, sacrificial altars and colonnaded streets.

Head further down in southern Jordan to visit other significant sites including Wadi Rum.

Explore Wadi Rum on around 1:30 hour for a Bedouin 4X4 ride into the Jordanian desert! Wadi Rum was best described by T.

E.

Lawrence as "Vast, echoing and god-like", and by the locals as "Valley of the Moon".

Later proceed to the sole gulf city in Jordan; Agaba.

Its sandy beaches and coral reefs are the most pristine on the Red Sea.

15,000+ steps #Facilities: Breakfast, guided tours, 4X4 ride, and transfers #Suitable for Age Group: Ages 12+ (active day with walking and adventure) #What to Bring: Sturdy shoes, sunscreen, hat, water bottle, and layered clothing for Wadi Rum #What to Do: Discover Petra's wonders, enjoy a 4X4 Bedouin ride, and relax in Aqaba #What Not to Do: Avoid overexerting yourself in Petra; take breaks as needed #Tip for You: Start your day early to avoid the midday heat in Petra #Overnight: Aqaba #Meal: Breakfast #Transfers: Hotel to attractions and then to Aqaba

DAY 5

Aqaba – Amman

Breakfast at the hotel.

Free time at leisure in Agaba.

Afternoon, transfer back to Amman via Wadi Araba Road.

3,000 steps #Facilities: Breakfast, free time, and transfers #Suitable for Age Group: All ages #What to Bring: Swimwear, casual clothing, and sunscreen #What to Do: Relax at Aqaba's beaches or explore local markets #What Not to Do: Avoid leaving sunscreen or hydration behind; Aqaba can get sunny #Tip for You: Try snorkeling to explore Aqaba's vibrant marine life #Overnight: Amman #Meal: Breakfast #Transfers: Aqaba to Amman transfer is included.

Departure through Q.Al Airport (AMM)

DAY 6

Breakfast at the hotel.

Later in time transfer to the airport, to catch a flight back home armed with tour enriching experience and happy memories to last a lifetime.

End of the trip.


